The current Miss England is performing arts student from Leicester “Grace Richardson” who will represent England at the 75th Anniversary of Miss World in August – 6th September 2026 in Vietnam .

The winner of the next Miss England contest will go forward to the Miss World 2027 final due to be held in Tanzania in May 2027 and the contest winner will receive \$100,000. As Amber Hood prepares to take to the stage, she represents a new generation of women using education, compassion, and determination to create meaningful change—both on and off the runway.
